Primary Changes: These are assessments of the conformation of the hip joint. The less well the femoral head ("ball") fits in the acetabulum ("socket") the more dysplastic the hip, the lower the score, the less dysplastic the hip appears.

Secondary Changes: These are the assessments of the arthritic response to the underlying dysplasia in various parts of the joint. They are likely to increase as the dog ages and the arthritis progresses.

NB: The scores represent the opinion of the BVA appointed scrutineers for the radiograph submitted. The lower the primary changes score, the less evidence of hip dysplasia there is and the lower the total score, the less evidence of hip dysplasia and secondary osteoarthritis there is.
